Dear Colleague:

Our journal, *Public Health Nursing* invites applications for positions on the Editorial Board. *Public Health Nursing* publishes empirical research reports, program evaluations, and case reports focused on populations at risk across the lifespan. The journal also prints articles related to developments in practice; education of public health nurses; theory development; methodological innovations; legal, ethical, and public policy issues in public health; and the history of public health nursing throughout the world. While our primary readership is in North America, the journal is expanding its mission to address global public health concerns of interest to nurses.

The official term of appointment is three years beginning February 1, 2022.

The workload varies with subject area but averages 5-6 manuscripts per year in established areas, with occasional second opinions on manuscripts handled by other Editors or referees. As well as reviewing manuscripts, Board Members are asked to identify and support one manuscript submission per year and to identify 4-5 potential reviewers for the journal who reflect disciplinary, human, and geographic diversity. We actively seek engagement with researchers from historically underrepresented groups and strive to build a more inclusive and equal community in nursing.

Selection considerations include:

- Scope of professional network;
- Familiarity with *Public Health Nursing* aims and scope and involvement with the journal as a previously published author or reviewer;
- Interest and experience in appropriate content and fields relevant to public health nursing;
- Current academic employment at a research university with a record of scholarly publications within nursing and/or public health.

OR

- History of practice in a public health nurse role as clinician, administrator or policy;

Self-nominations and applications from people in groups that have been historically excluded or underrepresented in the academic sector are encouraged.

Applications should include the following:

- A one-page letter of application
- A curriculum vita or resume

The submission deadline is February 1, 2022, although interested candidates are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. Please submit all application materials on or before the deadline to patriciajanekelly@gmail.com.
